Ultimately after several trips to Cornell University and one surgery paid for by Seeing Eye, the organization decided that Reggie could not be a guide dog due to health problems and asked us if we wanted to keep him as it was deemed it would be difficult to place him in an adoption situation. He had to be put down in 2007 due to his health problems. He weighed 95 pounds and I never walked him as he was too much for me to handle. My husband always had complete control of him. We also had and still have AJ wa stray from a rescue near Morgantown, West Virginia. He is ten and is healthy. He only weighs 60 pounds and I have always been able to control him in any situation. I consider him to be my small dog. He has not been a problem in the building. We did have one situation where my husband Paul was in the elevator on our floor waiting to go down when the previous owner in 1002 let her dog off leash and the dog raced into the elevator. The dog was aggressive; but Paul managed to get him out of the elevator and proceed to the lobby.
